Why Should You Support Our Annual Conference?

According to the FBI's National Crime Information Center, as of September 2014, there were 83,957 missing persons in the United States – 50,569 were adults and 33,388 were under the age of 18. While media often reports cases of abduction, many missing persons cases involve those who are absent from their homes due to a variety of reasons and a multitude of life stressors. The Missing and Unidentified Persons Conference (MUPC) focuses on marginalized and underreported groups of missing persons who often possess vulnerabilities that make them more at risk for harm, including physical and mental disabilities, emotional or physical abuse, substance dependence, aging, trauma, and catastrophic events.

The 11th Annual MUPC will focus on these vulnerable populations and the tragic circumstances behind their disappearance, whether due to criminal events or natural disasters. Titled *Multiple Victim Events and Serial Crimes – Implications for Investigation, Search, Rescue, and Recovery*, the conference will provide information on effective search and rescue strategies and approaches, death and forensic investigations, unidentified remains, and long-term missing person's cases. The National Criminal Justice Training Center (NCJTC) of Fox Valley Technical College is partnering again this year with the National Association For Search and Rescue (NASAR) to broaden the conference scope and continue its tradition of offering dynamic speakers who provide broad knowledge and expertise to the program.
