

## Scholarships

Scholarships are available for one point of contact from each jurisdiction. Please determine and select the individual to receive the scholarship during the registration process. Scholarship processing will occur through the National Criminal Justice Training Center at Fox Valley Technical College (NCJTC).

## Scholarship Processing

The approved point of contact accepting the award will receive confirmation of scholarship approval via Email provided at the time of registration.

The scholarship covers the following:

- Two nights of accommodations at the designated workshop hotel
- Up to \$500 in reimbursement for air/rail fare for non-local recipients
- Up to \$381 in reimbursement for mileage for local recipients
- Up to one full day and two travel days federal per diem

This funding will not cover any additional costs. With the exception of accommodations, this scholarship is a reimbursement and itemized receipts for air/rail travel must be submitted for reconciliation. Detailed reimbursement forms will be sent to qualified individuals at a later date.

Please remember when making your travel arrangements that the 2018 SORNA Workshop commences Tuesday, January 9, 2018, 9:00 a.m. Mountain Standard Time (MST) and concludes Wednesday, January 10, 2018, 12:00 p.m. MST.

Please make your own accommodations at the workshop hotel, DoubleTree by Hilton at the Albuquerque Convention Center, by calling (800) 584-5058. You will be required to provide a credit card that will be kept on file for incidentals and late cancellation fees. NCJTC staff will arrange for up to two applicable nights and taxes to be billed directly to NCJTC upon the scholarship recipient's departure.

The DoubleTree Albuquerque offers shuttle airport service to accommodate all their guests. The airport shuttle service is available by calling the hotel directly from 5:00 a.m. until 12:00 a.m. daily at no charge.

As a scholarship recipient, you agree to attend all the sessions and not leave early, unless an unexpected emergency arises and you alert a NCJTC team member.
