This sex trafficking awareness project was designed for students in grades seven through 12. This online site offers a series of syllabi for teachers, activities for student groups, training materials for school social workers, school nurses, and school administrators. There is an online training that produces a completion certificate. Within the training there are examples of school policies regarding plans to report sex trafficking in each community. The site also offers examples of parental consent forms and tools to use for community education.
