A questionnaire of this type, with adequate space for the officer to write the responses given as well as any comments the officer may have, will enable the canvassing officer to complete the written reports immediately. The reports, therefore, will be timely, and will also contain much more potentially useful information. The time spent by an investigator in charge of a major case investigation in drafting the neighborhood canvass questionnaire and in briefing the canvassing is time well spent. The information developed during a neighborhood canvass might well provide the information which will lead to a successful solution to the case.
