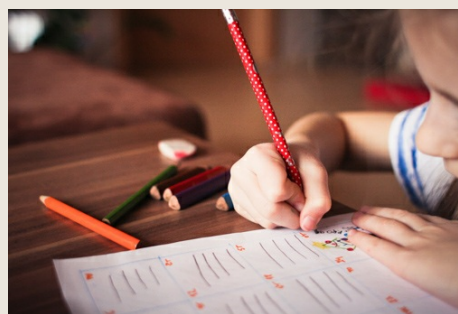

Reunification is the process of reuniting children with their parents or guardians after an emergency or disastrous event at their school.

In these situations, a traditional student release process is unsafe and often lacks the necessary organization to be successful.
