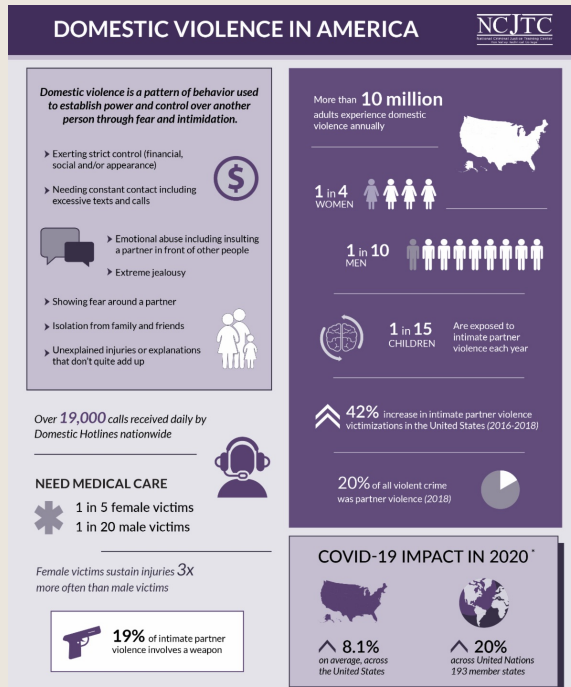




## National Domestic Violence Prevention Month

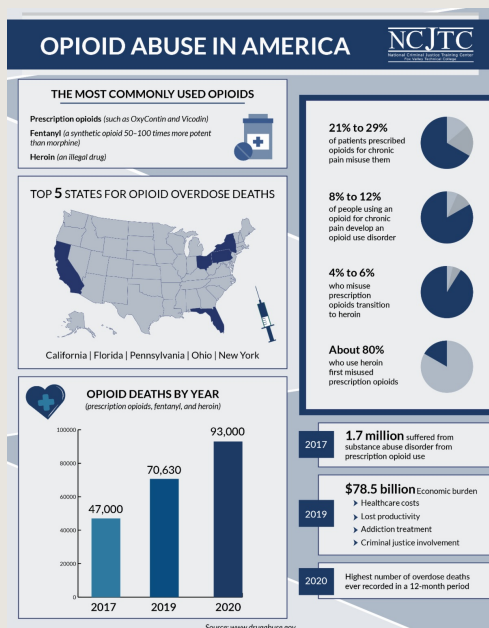

### New Research Published [Information Sharing and the Role of Sex Offender Registration and Notification, 2009 - 2017](#)

The purpose of this study was to see how effective the inter-jurisdictional consistency and coordination of SORN (sex offender registration and notification) systems operating within the United States under SORNA (The Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act).

This study was conducted by investigators from University of Massachusetts-Lowell, San Diego State University; and the National Criminal Justice Training Center of Fox Valley Technical College (NCJTC).
