
12,100,000 adults report serious thoughts of suicide

28,000,000

individuals with mental illness receive no treatment

of all adults with a mental illness report that they were not able to receive the treatment they need

Individuals needing treatment for a mental illness outnumber mental health providers



YOUTH

2,700,000 youth are experiencing severe major depression

16.39% of youth (age 12-17)



report suffering from at least one major depressive episode (MDE) in the past year

U.S. high school students reported schoolwork was more difficult

experienced some emotional abuse in the home

reported they did not have enough food to eat

experienced physical abuse

6.34% report a substance use disorder

1,200,000 youth with private insurance do not have coverage for mental or emotional difficulties



of youth with major depression do not receive mental health treatment

Only 28% of youth with severe depression receive some consistent treatment (7-25+ visits in a year)
