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

## NCJTC June Event Recap

June was a busy month for our NCJTC associates; we successfully hosted two major conferences in Wisconsin and served as exhibitors at the 2024 National Law Enforcement Training on Child Exploitation Conference (NLETCE) in Atlanta, GA.

We held our annual *School Resource Officer Training Conference* in Oshkosh, WI to kick off the month of June. This year's event brought over 200 SROs together, paving the way for collaborative breakout training sessions, panels, case studies, and presentations. This conference addresses school violence and youth victimization concerns by teaching relevant, and innovative crime prevention and response strategies. The following week (June 19), we kicked off an impactful and informative 3-day conference in Green Bay, WI - our Wisconsin Law Enforcement Administrative Professionals Conference (LEAP). 


