VICTIMIZATION RATE PER 1,000 IN THEIR POPULATION

Over half a million children were identified as victims of abuse and neglect in 2023. This equates to a victimization rate of 7.4 per 1,000 children in the population. Victimization rate helps assess the prevalence and scope of victimization.








Children <1 years old experience the highest victimization rate (21.0% per 1,000)
