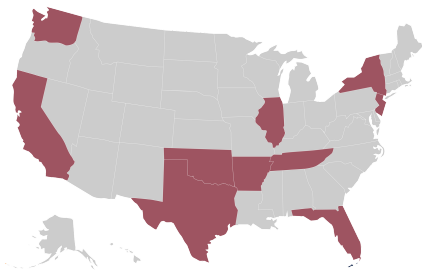

Top 10 States with highest number of missing person cases reported (in February 2026)

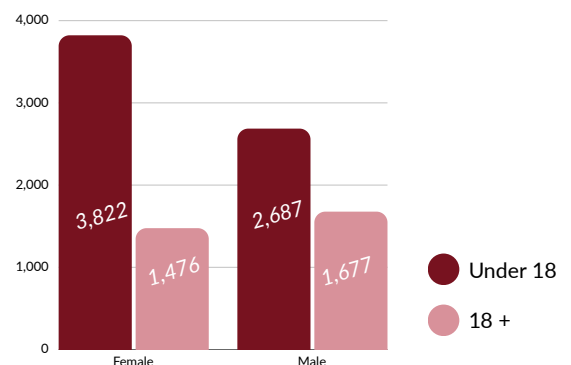
